Basic Criteria for Consideration:

- 1) Students must be currently enrolled and in good standing in a LCGME approved medical school.
- 2) Must be 4th year medical student at the time of clerkship.
- 3) Must be planning to specialize in Family Medicine.
- 4) Once approved, students will need to provide: Immunizations, 8-Panel Drug Screen, 2-Step PPD TB Test and Flu shot (only applicable October–April).
- 5) With application, students must provide:
 - Letter of good standing
 - Proof of liability coverage from their sponsoring school/institution
 - Current CV
 - USMLE/COMLEX test scores report
